PRIZE MONEY PROGRAM FOR 2008

The Arizona Dressage Association Prize Money Program will be administered according to the following guidelines:

Five dollars from each class fee at the Spring Celebration and Fall Fiesta Shows will be transferred to the prize money pool. Prize money will be paid at the Spring Celebration and Fall Fiesta Open Shows for designated classes.

The prize money pool will be used exclusively for prize money and awards as designated by the ADA Board of Directors. Awards for other achievements, such as high points and year-end awards are yet to be determined as the program develops.

Class purse amounts will be assigned based on the prize money pool designated for that show. Prize money will be paid for Open, AA and Jr/YR Divisions in each prize money class or combination of classes. The purse is paid to the first three places on a scale of 50%/30%/20%. If one person is in the class, they receive the 50% share. If two are in the class, a 50%/30% split is paid. Unpaid prize money will go back into the prize money pool for subsequent Spring Celebration and Fall Fiesta Open Shows, or other awards.

Prize money is awarded to the first three places in Training through Fourth Levels and two combined FEI categories. The two USDF and FEI Freestyle TOC classes are combined and paid to the three highest scores regardless of level or division.

Prize Money Classes

- Class 204 Training Test 4
- Class 214 First Level Test 4
- Class 224 Second Level Test 4
- Class 233 Third Level Test 3
- Class 243 Fourth Level Test 3
- Classes 251 Prix St. Georges and 252 Intermediare I combined.
- Classes 253 Intermediare II, 254 Grand Prix and 255 Grand Prix Special combined.
- Classes 266 USDF Freestyle (TOC), 267 FEI Freestyle (TOC) combined. Prize money to the highest three scores regardless of division or level ridden.

Criteria: A minimum score of 55% must be achieved to be eligible to receive prize money.

Payment of Prize Money: Checks for prize money will be mailed within 30 days of the end of the show to the Owner or Lessee of record. If you are leasing a horse, it is possible to obtain forms from USEF/USDF to record the horse as being leased by a separate individual. Otherwise, the owner of record will receive prize money.

Ties: Ties will not be broken. Ties in classes which involve prize money shall remain tied for the purpose of dividing prize money.
