### ADA SPRING CELEBRATION SHOW - APRIL 5-6, 2008 WESTWORLD OF SCOTTSDALE

**Greetings to Competitors from the Show Manager, Peggy Farmer**  
**Please read both pages of this letter. It contains important information.**

A map of the show layout accompanies this letter. You may encounter parking attendants as you enter the grounds. Tell them you are with the horse show and you will not be expected to pay for parking.

ADA is conducting an L Program Testing session at this show. Ring 6 is our primary L Program location.

**PURCHASE EXTRA BEDDING USING THE ATTACHED FORM.** All overnight horse and tack stalls will receive two bales of shavings. Our contract with WestWorld specifies that additional bedding be purchased from the on-site vendor, Performance Feed and Bedding. An order form is attached for your convenience and should be faxed to them by Wednesday before the show.

**COMPETITOR MIXER FRIDAY AFTERNOON:** Location: Equidome from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. Sweet Things will prepare a delicious Polynesian-themed meal. We'll have a No Host Bar open at 5:00 p.m.

**FUNDRAISER FOR REGION 5 JR/YR TEAMS: "Let Your Mane Down for the Region 5 FEI JR/YR."** For a donation of \$30 (or more), the JR/YR's will make ribbons to put in the horse's forelock showing support for the Region 5 JR/YR Teams. The competitor could either "let the mane down" or have it braided. Our judges will be advised that this is being done for the Fundraiser. It does not involve breaking any rule, so riders will not be penalized for showing without braids. Tammy Fitch, Region 5 FEI JR/YR Coordinator is conducting the fundraiser at tables set up in Equidome beginning at the Friday Mixer.

**NOMINATE YOUR HORSE TO QUALIFY FOR 2008 STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS.** TDC will host the 2008 Arizona State Dressage Championship show. You can obtain qualifying scores at this show. In order for your scores to count, you must submit a Horse Nomination Form accompanied by a one-time fee of \$25 made payable to Tucson Dressage Club. This fee must be paid before any rides will count toward qualifying. Since only one horse/rider combination can compete at a Championship, the fee goes toward the horse. Multiple riders may qualify on the same horse if the nomination fee has been paid for that horse. We'll have forms in the Show Office.

**BRIDLE NUMBERS:** There are three bridle numbers per horse for this show. One is for the halter. Please place the other two on each side of the bridle, on boots or saddle pad. This will help ring stewards and scribes identify your horse. USEF Rules require that numbers be displayed whenever horses are out of their stalls. Please check in and obtain numbers prior to working horses. **All horses are to be wearing numbers by 3:00 p.m. Friday.**

**EQUIDOME SAFETY:** One horse at a time entering and exiting Equidome tunnels, please. Horses passing each other in confined spaces may kick. It has happened at other venues and we want to prevent it here.

**MOVE-IN begins Thursday (after 12:00 noon) and move-out day is Sunday.** Tanya Missureli, our Barn Manager, will be on duty beginning Thursday afternoon to help folks move in and to give parking directions.

**FRIDAY MOVE IN BEGINS AFTER 7:00 AM.** Tanya will be on duty beginning at 7:00 am.

**Competitors arriving after 5:00 PM must contact the Barn Manager to make arrangements for stall access**

**WARM-UP DAYS:** The following rings will be open Thursday: Ring 5 Lungeing, Ring 5A, Ring 6. All rings will be open Friday, but ring set-up will be a priority, so access may be limited while rings are being set.

**BARN CHARTS, Trailer and Vehicle Parking.** Barn Charts will be posted at [www.azdressage.org](http://www.azdressage.org) by Tuesday, April 1.

- Groups of five or less may not appear on the barn charts since their locations are subject to change. You can verify that we have your information by checking the Unassigned Groups page included along with the barn charts. Upon arrival, contact Tanya Missureli, the Barn Manager, at 480 390 0143. She will direct you to your location.
- Parking restrictions established by WestWorld will be strictly enforced for the safety of horses and competitors. **For safety reasons, it is imperative that no vehicles of any kind be parked in inner or outer barn aisles.**
- Each stall should have a stall card in case of emergency. Please put up a stall card or we will provide one for your use.

**SHOW OFFICE LOCATED IN EQUIDOME. LOOK FOR THE BLUE POP-UP CANOPY OUTSIDE THE SOUTHEAST CORNER:** **HOURS:** Friday: 9-12 a.m. and 1-5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday: 7:00 a.m. to end of show day.

**Please note the following policy regarding golf carts or any motorized vehicle**

**Motorized Vehicles. USEF GR301.5:**

(a) Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 7. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**Pets: USEF GR301.6:** Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards.

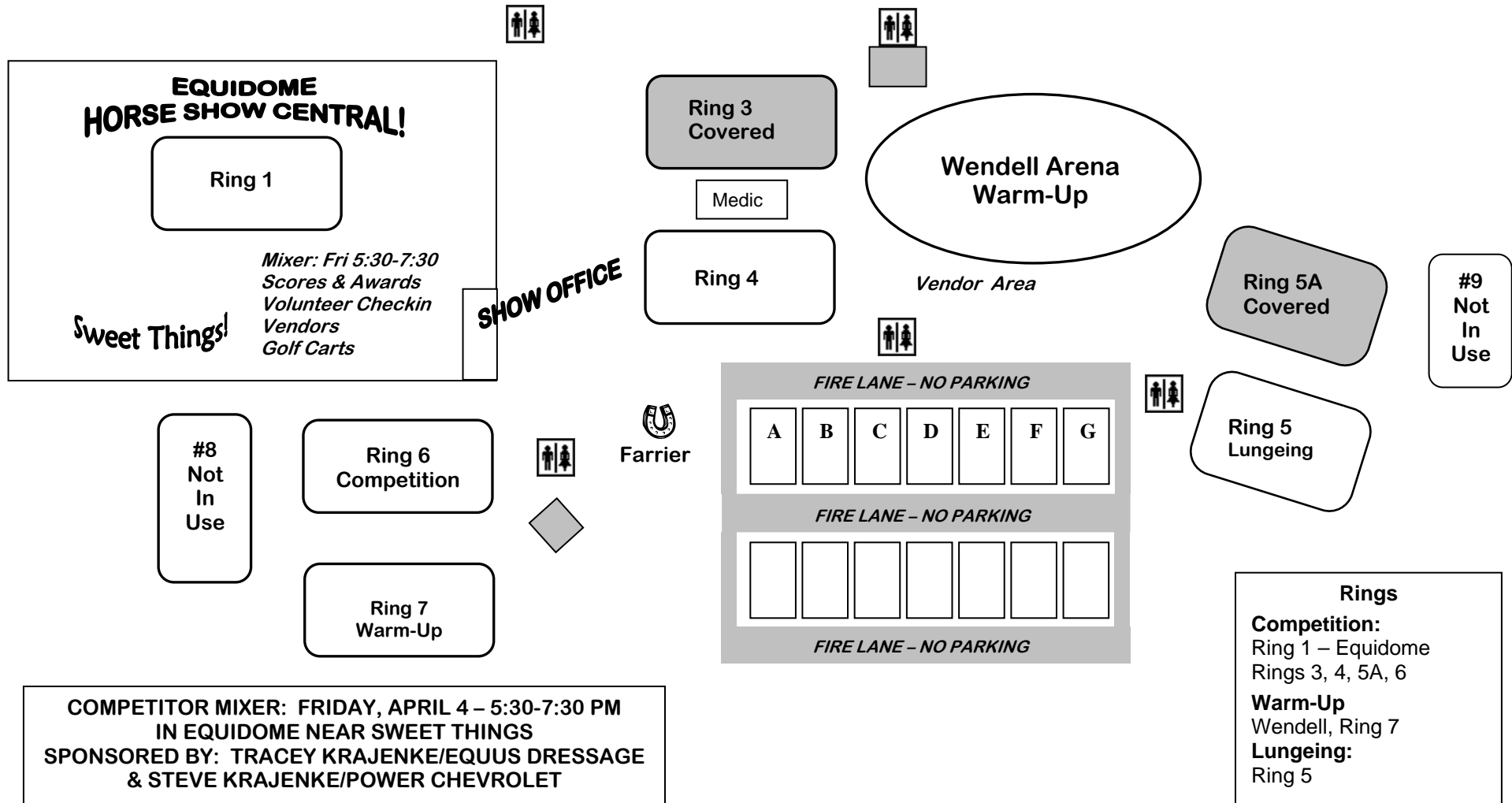
