

## **PRIZE LIST STABLING POLICY ADA RECOGNIZED SHOWS**

Competitors at ADA recognized shows should be aware of some changes in how stall assignments are made for shows at WestWorld and Fort Tuthill. These changes will primarily affect entries that are received well after the entry closing date.

Competitors at our shows typically request to be stabled with a particular training group for convenience and sharing tack stalls. When entries are received before or shortly after the entry closing date, it is easy for the Show Secretary and Barn Manager to accommodate these requests.

Contracts with both venues require ADA to submit stabling charts approximately a week in advance of the shows for planning and to ensure accurate delivery of bedding orders. This requirement creates a challenge when we accept late entries, particularly Schooling Only entries that come in only a few days prior to the show. The Barn Manager makes every attempt to keep training groups together or follow individual stabling requests. She typically leaves one or two stalls between the large training groups to allow for changes. However, we have to keep barn usage to a minimum and not “grow” beyond the reasonable number of barns our show would occupy for its size.

Please make sure that you include the group or trainer you want to be stabled with or share a tack room with on your entry. If you have a more detailed or complicated request than can be explained on the entry form, please email your request to the Barn Manager. The Barn Manager contact information will be available on the ADA website for each show.

### **The updated ADA stabling policy is as follows:**

Stabling assignments for stalls or tack rooms will not be made until entries are received and processed. ADA will make every attempt to meet stabling requests for late entries if there happens to be space near their requested stabling group. However, if entries are received after stabling charts are filed with the venue and/or posted online, they may be placed in separate stabling. Stabling charts will be available on the ADA website by 5:00 PM three days prior to the shows.
