Entry Procedures: For each horse/rider combination entered, send the completed entry form and all fees to Show Secretary. Make checks payable to ADA. Entries must be **received** by the closing date.

Class Fees: FEI, NAJYRC, Brentina Cup (all riders) \$60; Junior (18 and under) \$40; All Others \$50. Great American/USDF qualifier classes add \$10.

State Championship Classes: FEI \$65; Junior rider (18 and under) \$45; All others \$55. State Championship qualifying scores must have been earned to enter Classes 170-279. Horse nomination fee must have been paid for scores to be eligible. Rider must be a member of an Arizona GMO by August 31, 2010 to ride in 2010 State Championship classes. See 2010 State Championship Rules in the prize list. If you enter a State Championship class which you are not qualified/eligible for, you will not receive a refund.

ADA Prize Money Classes: See Class List. Refer to ADA 2010 Prize Money Program. The amount of prize money is determined in part by the number of class entries. A portion of each class fee is designated for the prize money pool. A score of 55% or better must be achieved to be eligible for prize money.

Dover Medal Class: Class 123 – Second Level Test 3. See Standard Show Rules.

Office Fee: \$30. Non-refundable. **Refunds:** No refunds (including stabling) for any reason after the closing date, including cancellation of a class or classes, or all or part of the competition due to severe weather, accident or any other emergency. **Scratches:** Scratches before the closing date may be made for any reason and all fees will be refunded except the office fee.

Late/Post Entries: Accepted as space allows. Add \$30 per entry.

Changes: Changes are \$10 per change, if allowed. Bring \$10 to the show office when you request the change.

Not Competing (Schooling) Horses: Must pay a \$20.00 schooling fee, office fee, plus stabling or trailer in fee.

Leadline Demonstration: To be held during Saturday lunch break, location to be announced. Treat as a Not Competing Horse. For riders eight and under. Questions, call Show Manager.

Stabling (no bedding included): \$135 for Thursday (check in after 12:00 noon) through Sunday (check out by 6:30pm), \$100 for Friday (check in after 7:00am) through Sunday (check out by 6:30pm). Inform the show secretary of stabling requirements. Permanent 10 x 12 stalls with doors. Shavings only. The ADA contract with WestWorld specifies that all shavings be purchased on-site. All horses on site overnight must be stabled. **Day Stall:** (6am-6pm) \$50. **Trailer-in/day:** \$35.

Ride Times: Preliminary ride times and a show schedule will be available on ADA's website, AZDressage.org. Final ride times will be posted at the show by noon, Friday. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to verify final ride times at the show. Please notify the show secretary of any scheduling conflicts. Ride times will be mailed only if you include a #10 SASE.

Arenas: Footing is a sand/dirt mixture. All tests will be ridden in 20 x 60m arenas. During the show, competition arenas will be open to hand walking only outside the dressage court up to one half hour prior to the first class and mounted schooling in arenas after the end of each competition day.

Awards: First Place-Prize and Ribbon for Open, AA and Jr/YR Divisions. Ribbons awarded through 6th place. Divisions with 3 or fewer entries may be combined for awarding ribbons. Test of Choice class placing will be determined by division, ranking scores by percentage, regardless of which test is ridden within each class.

Golf Cart Rental: Friday through Sunday Rental. 2 Passenger \$150, 4 Passenger or utility wagon \$180. To reserve, contact Show Manager by 10/22. Cancellation of golf cart reservations accepted until 10/23.
