**Entry Procedures:** For each horse/rider combination entered, please send your completed entry form and all fees. Make checks payable to TDC and mail to the show secretary. Entries must be **received** by 6 pm on the closing date.

**Credit Card/ Fax Fee:** Visa or MasterCard accepted with additional \$10 fee. Faxed entries accepted with credit card and fee.

**Incorrect or Incomplete Entry:** Up to \$25 fee for any entry (including faxed entries) without all required copies of current registrations, membership cards, proof of eligibility and signatures.

**Class Schedule:** See page 15. Updates will be posted on TDC website, [tucsondressageclub.org](http://tucsondressageclub.org)

**Dover Medal Class:** Class 123; Second Level, Test 3. Please see Show Rules section of this Omnibus for eligibility and program description.

**Class Fees:** FEI, Young Horse (all riders) \$55, Junior rider (18 and under) \$35, All Others \$45. Great American/USDF qualifier classes add \$10.

**Sweepstakes Classes:** All sweepstakes riders will be combined for payout for each level by division (open, AA or JR/YR). Winner takes all, 1-3 riders; 4 or more riders, 70%/30%. Prize money will be mailed to rider within 30 days after the show. Add \$10 to class fee for designated stakes classes to participate.

**Stabling:** \$90 for Friday through Sunday, 2 bags bedding included. Additional nights \$35/night.

**Day Stall:** (6am-6pm) \$45. One bag bedding provided.

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**Bedding:** Additional shavings may be ordered at \$9 per bag. Indicate the number of additional bags on the entry form.

**Trailer in/day:** \$25 (do not pay if you've paid for stabling or a day stall)

**Office Fee:** \$30; Non-refundable. **Refunds:** No refunds after the closing date, including cancellation of a class or classes, or cancellation of all or part of the competition due to severe weather, accident or other emergency.

**Late/Post Entries:** Accepted as space allows. Add \$25 per entry.

**Scratches:** Exhibitors have the responsibility of informing the show office of their intention to scratch. Scratches before the closing date may be made for any reason and all fees will be refunded except the office fee.

**Ride Times:** Preliminary ride times and a show schedule will be available on TDC's website, [tucsondressageclub.org](http://tucsondressageclub.org). Final ride times will be posted at the show by noon, Friday. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to verify final ride times at the show. Please notify the show secretary of any scheduling conflicts. **Ride times will not be mailed.**

**Changes:** Changes are \$10 per change, if allowed. Bring your \$10 to the show office when you request the change.

**Not Entered (Schooling) Horses:** Must pay a \$15.00 schooling fee, office fee, plus stabling, day or trailer-in fee.

**Numbers:** All horses on the show grounds must have a number on while out of their stalls.

**Leadline Demonstration:** For riders 8 and under. To be treated as Not Entered Horses. Will be held during Saturday lunch break.

**Stabling:** Temporary 10 x 10 stalls with doors, first bedding is provided. Shavings only, no straw or outside shavings allowed on the grounds.

**Arenas:** Footing is sand/dirt mixture. All tests will be ridden in 20 x 60m arenas. The competition arenas are open for schooling on Friday, and at the end of competition on Saturday. No schooling in arenas on Thursday.

**Parking:** No car or trailer parking between the barns and arenas. Trailers must be parked in designated areas.

**Awards:** First Place-Prize and Ribbon. Ribbons awarded through 6th place. High Point Awards for USEF classes will be given to the horse/rider combination earning the highest average of two scores in a division. FEI High Point Award will be given to the single highest score earned in FEI classes. Scores earned in Junior, Amateur and Open classes and divisions count only toward the respective High Point award. Young Rider scores will count toward Open or Junior High Point at management discretion. Scores from Freestyle, Para-equestrian or equitation classes do not count for High Point. High Point awards offered: Open, Adult Amateur and Junior; Training-FEI by level.

**Ties:** Management reserves the right to break ties based on collective marks. Stakes class ties will not be broken, prize money will be split.

**Directions:** Exit I-10 at Houghton Rd. Go South (right) on Houghton. Turn right on Brekke Rd. Turn left into Pima County Fairgrounds.

**RV Fee:** Contact Southwest Fair Commission at 520-762-9108 for costs and to reserve a space.

**Lodging:** Please see website for list of hotels. **Concessions:** Available on the grounds.

**Operation of Motorized Vehicles:** USEF rule GR 301.5 applies. Please see USEF Rules section of this Omnibus.
